



## 2021 Riesling Elkton OR AVA

Our 2021 riesling comes from the Anindor Vineyard in our Elkton Oregon AVA. Cuttings from the original Ken Thomason Elkton planting dating to 1972 were used by the Bing family to plant theirs in 1983. These west facing slopes have windblown soils originating in the Cascades, Coast Range and Siskiyou, carried to Elkton by the Umpqua River. This site has proven to be excellent for this late ripening variety and our cool maritime climate here in Elkton allows for full flavors and aromatics to develop. The 2021 harvest came in on October 4.

This wine opens with aromas of ripe pears and juicy red Gaja apple with hints of melon, Meyer lemon and sweet honeysuckle. The entry is crisp and racy and as the wine warms in your mouth all of these fruit flavors emerge and the texture becomes more supple. The finish is very pleasing, tart and lingering.

Riesling is such a versatile wine to pair with so many different cuisines. Right now I can see this matching well with sushi, curry dishes, honey soy roasted pork, cheese souffles, sautéed fish preparations with spicy or fruit-based sauces, soft cheeses and fruit or a simple BLT.
